

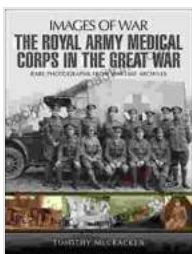

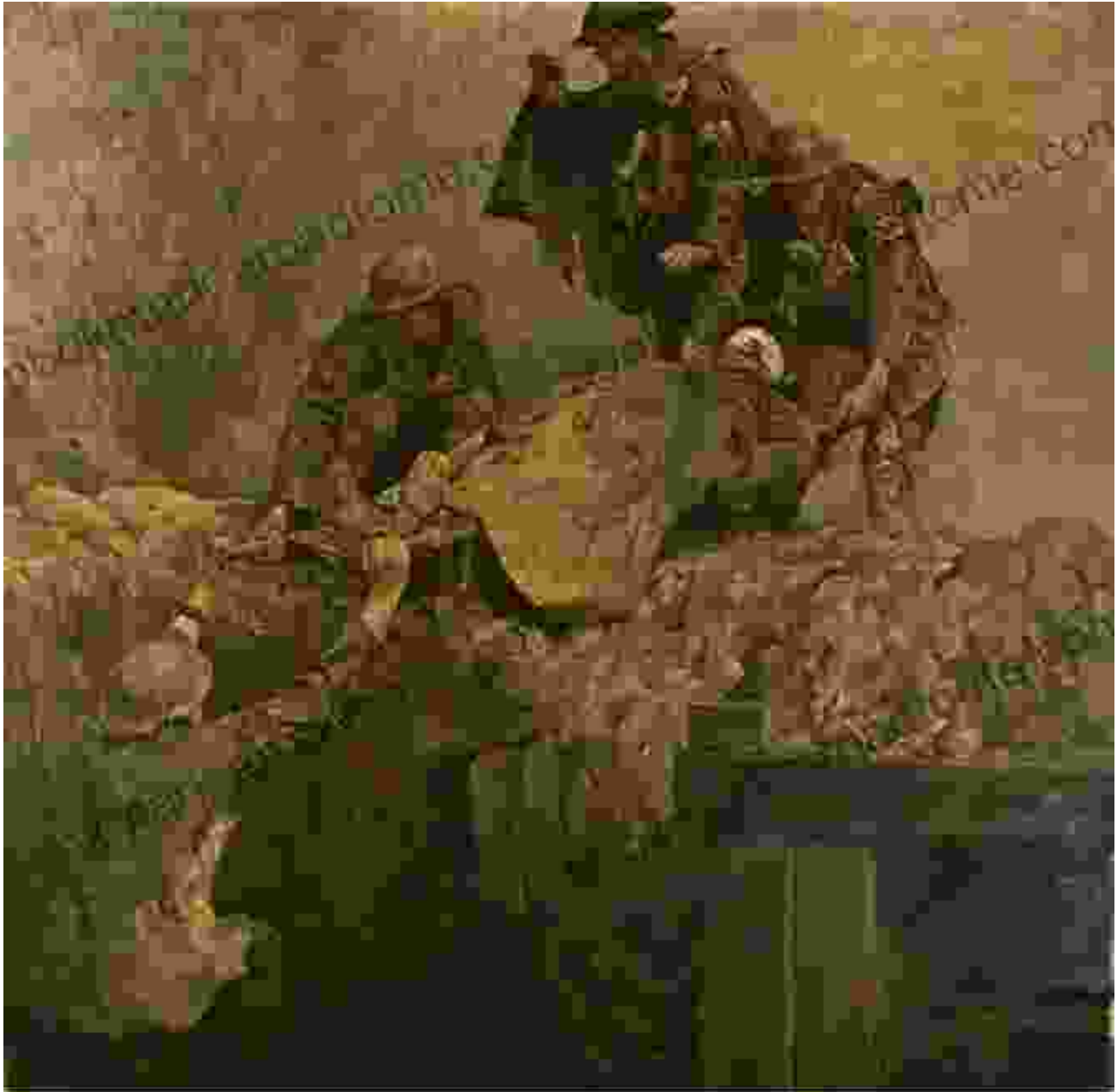
Women in the RAMC:

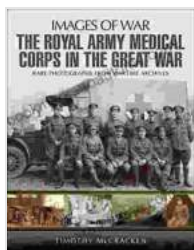

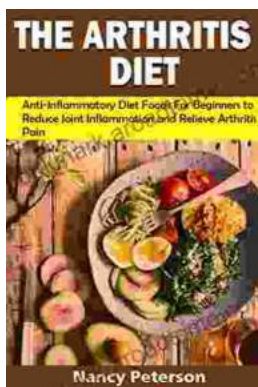

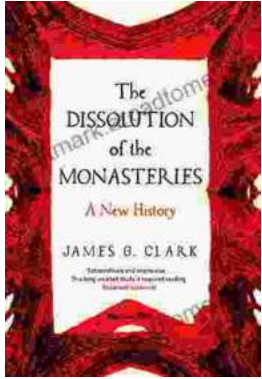
